PILGRIMAGE TO THE HOLY LAND

March 16-27, 2026



Day 1 - March 16: Depart USA

Our pilgrimage begins as we depart on our overnight flight to Tel Aviv.

Day 2 - March 17: Arrive in Tel Aviv

Upon arrival at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv, we will be met and then transfer to our hotel located on the shores of the Mediterranean in Tel Aviv. (D)



Day 3 - March 18: Tel Aviv / Galilee

This morning depart Tel Aviv and drive along the Mediterranean coast to the lower Galilee where we will visit Mt. Tabor, the mountain where Jesus was transfigured before Peter, James, and John. We will then proceed to Nazareth, Jesus' hometown. Here we visit the Basilica of the Annunciation and St. Joseph's Church, the site of the home of the Holy Family. The Synagogue Church is about a ten minute walk from the basilica. We will then drive to Cana, the site of the first miracle. Couples will have the opportunity to renew their marriage vows here. Our day comes to an end with a drive to Tiberias, our home for the next two nights. (B/D)

Day 4 - March 19: Galilee

We begin with a visit to the Primacy of Peter. Next a drive to the north will bring us to Caesarea Philippi where Jesus declares to Peter that "You are Peter and, on this Rock,..." In the afternoon we will visit Bethsaida, the hometown of Peter, Andrew and Phillip, and the place where Jesus cured a blind man. A visit to the site of the Miracle of the Swine at Kursi rounds out the afternoon. (B/L/D)




Day 5 - March 20: Galilee

This morning, enjoy a scenic boat ride across the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum, where Jesus lived during His ministry. After visiting the synagogue where he taught, drive to Tabgha - the site of the multiplication of loaves and fishes. Next, drive to the Mount of Beatitudes to visit the site of the Sermon on the Mount. The remainder of the day is at your disposal. (B/D)

Day 6 - March 21: Tiberias / Petra

Depart Tiberias and drive to the Sheikh Hussein Bridge where we cross into Jordan. Our first stop will be the traditional Baptismal Site on the River Jordan, where we will renew our Baptismal Promises and view Elijah's Hill, the place from which the great prophet ascended into heaven in a fiery chariot. Next stop at Mt. Nebo, the site from which Moses saw the Promised Land and then died. If we have a clear day, we may even capture a glimpse of Jerusalem's skyline. The highlight of our day will be the descent into magnificent Petra, one of the Seven Wonders of the World. (B/D)



Day 7 - March 22: Petra / Amman

This morning, pass through the "siq" to the ancient city of Petra, which was rediscovered in 1912. Sandstone cliffs enclose the valley, shading it with shades of red, purple, and pale yellow. The Nabatean Arabs founded this "rose-red" city as their capital. We'll be awed as we view the masterpieces of the Treasury made famous by the movie "Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade," the Monastery, the Triumphal Arch and the Roman Amphitheatre. Then depart Petra and drive to Amman, the capital of Jordan, which, like Rome, sprawls over seven hills and was constructed by the Romans according to a traditional city plan. (B/D)

Day 8 - March 23: Amman / Jerusalem

This morning, we will check out of our hotel and drive to the Allenby Bridge to cross back into Israel from Jordan. Proceed to ancient Jericho, which has sites connected with both the Old Testament and the Gospels. We will then proceed to the Dead Sea for the opportunity to float in its mineral-rich waters. Then we will drive up to Jerusalem for check-in at our hotel. (B/L/D)

Day 9 - March 24: Jerusalem

Traveling a short distance south of Jerusalem, we arrive in Bethlehem. We begin our visit to the countryside at Shepherds' Field to remember the angels' glad tidings to the shepherds. Within the town of Bethlehem, we go to venerate the Holy Grotto of the Nativity, the Manger and the Grotto of St. Jerome. We will also visit the Franciscan Church of St. Catherine, the site of Bethlehem's Christmas Midnight Mass. Visit Bethlehem University and the Creche Orphanage. This afternoon, we travel to Ein Karem to visit the Church of St. John the Baptist, the birthplace of the Precursor of the Lord, and the Church of the Visitation, where we recall Mary's prayer of praise, the Magnificat. (B/L/D)



Day 10 - March 25: Jerusalem

This morning, we enter the Old City of Jerusalem at St. Stephen's Gate, where our first stop is at the Church of St. Anne and the Pool of Bethesda. Next, we make our way to the Church of the Flagellation, which marks the beginning of the Via Dolorosa, ending on Calvary. We enter the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, and within the church, we visit Golgotha and complete our devotions at the Holy Sepulchre, the sacred tomb of Jesus. In the afternoon, we visit the Western Wall, also known as the Wailing Wall, where prayers are offered at these remaining holy stones of the glorious second temple compound. We are aware that, currently, the only structures standing on the Temple Mount are the Muslim Shrines of the Dome of the Rock and the Al-Agsa Mosque. We drive along the walls of the Old City to Mt. Zion. Next, we visit the Upper Room's nearby traditional site, remembering the Last Supper, a post-Resurrection appearance, and Pentecost. Nearby, we see Dormition Abbey Church, which honours Mary's "falling asleep." We conclude the day with a visit to St. Peter in Gallicantu, which marks the site of Peter's denial. (B/L/D)

Day 11 - March 26: Jerusalem

This morning, we drive to the summit of the Mount of Olives to visit the Chapel of the Ascension and the Church of the Pater Noster. Walking the Palm Sunday Road, we will see the Chapel of Dominus Flevit. There, we have a fantastic panoramic view of the city of Jerusalem. We continue down the road to the Garden of Gethsemane and visit the Basilica of the Agony. Nearby is the

Grotto of the Judas' Betrayal and Mary's Tomb, the site of Mary's Assumption. Then proceed to Bethany where Our Lord would come to recuperate in the home of His loving friends, Mary, Martha and Lazarus before setting out once more on His arduous task. This evening, a special dinner will be arranged in our honor at a typical Middle Eastern restaurant. (B/D)



Day 12 - March 27: Jerusalem / Tel Aviv / USA

Drive to Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv to catch our return flight home.

Once we have met the minimum number of required participants a member of our staff will reach out to you to assist you in booking your flights. In the meantime, please refrain from booking flights on your own until we have greater confidence that the tour will materialize.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS

Reservations and Payment: Please complete the attached Reservation Application and return it with your deposit of \$300.00 per person at the time of booking. Final payment is due 65 days prior to departure.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be in writing. Cancellations received after 5PM Pacific Time or on weekends/holidays will be processed the next business day. The following per person cancellation charges will apply: If canceled 91 days or more prior to departure, a \$50.00 administrative fee will be charged. If canceled 90 - 61 days prior to departure, \$250.00 will be charged. If canceled 60 - 31 days prior to departure, \$450.00 will be charged. If canceled 30 - 7 days prior to departure \$700.00 will be charged. No refunds will be made within 6 days of departure. In addition, once the airline tickets have been issued, 100% of the airfare is non-refundable unless you have been advised otherwise at the time of your booking. Additional cancellation charges may apply depending upon the cancellation terms of our suppliers.

Refunds: Subject to the foregoing Cancellation Terms, upon cancellation of travel related services, all sums paid to George's International Tours for such services will be promptly returned to the passenger, provided the passenger is not in violation of any of the terms and conditions previously, clearly and conspicuously disclosed and agreed to by the passenger. This refund provision does not apply where George's International Tours has remitted the payment to another registered seller of travel or a carrier and they default in providing the agreed-upon transportation or service without providing a refund. In such a situation, George's International Tours agrees to provide passenger with a written statement accompanied by a copy of the bank records establishing the disbursement of the payment, and if disbursed to a seller of travel, proof of their current registration.

Trust Account Disclosure: California law requires certain sellers of travel to have a trust account or bond. George's International Tours has such a trust account.

Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"): George's International Tours is a participant in the Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"). You, the passenger, may request reimbursement from TCRC if the Seller of Travel was registered and participating in the TCRC at the time of sale and the passenger is located in California at the time of payment. Please be advised that passengers purchasing from outside of California are not covered by the TCRC. Eligible passengers may file a claim with TCRC if the passenger is owed a refund of more than \$50 for transportation or travel services which the Seller of Travel failed to forward to a proper provider or if such money was not refunded to you when required. The maximum amount which may be paid by the TCRC to any one passenger is the total amount paid on behalf of the passenger to the Seller of Travel, not to exceed \$15,000. A claim must be submitted to the TCRC within six months after the scheduled completion date of the travel. A claim must include sufficient information and documentation to prove your claim and a \$35 processing fee. You must agree to waive your right to other civil remedies against a registered participating Seller of Travel for matters arising out of a sale for which you file a claim with the TCRC, if you were located in California at the time of the sale. You may request a claim form by writing to: Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation, P.O. Box 6001, Larkspur, CA 94977-6001; or by faxing a request to 415-927-7698.

Travel Documents: A passport which is valid for a minimum of 6 months past the date of your return flight home is required of all U.S. citizens. U.S. citizens require visas for entry to Jordan and the cost of this visa has included in the cost of your trip and George's International Tours will be procuring a group visa on your behalf. U.S. citizens do not require visas for entry to Israel, however they are required to obtain an electronic travel authorization (ETA-IL) which can be done online for a fee of approximately \$6.00 per person. Instructions on obtaining the ETA-IL will be provided upon your registration. If you are not a U.S. citizen, please call to determine your Jordanian visa and Israel ETA-IL requirement status. George's International Tours is not responsible for individual visas, passports or other travel documents.

Tour Cost: All quoted prices are based upon airfares, tariffs and currency exchange rates at the time of printing and are subject to change at any time. Should the minimum number of 20 tour members not be reached, the right is reserved to increase the tour cost accordingly.

Tour Documents and Tickets: Final tour documents are mailed, provided we have received full payment, within 3 weeks of departure.

Baggage: Each passenger is allowed 1 checked bag and 1 carry-on. You will be responsible for paying to the airline any charges for additional checked baggage or overweight baggage (if excess weight is permitted). George's International Tours is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen baggage.

Air Transportation: Airfare is not included in the published tour cost. Once we have met the minimum number of required participants a member of our staff will reach out to you to assist you in booking your flights. In the meantime, please refrain from booking flights on your own until we have greater confidence that the tour will materialize.

Hotels: Accommodations are based on double occupancy rooms. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement quoted, and should be requested at the time of booking.

Travel Insurance: We strongly recommend that you have comprehensive travel insurance. Insurance may be purchased directly through George's International Tours and registration forms will be provided upon receipt of your deposit or you may purchase online at www.georgesintl.com. Not Included: Gratuities (\$250.00 recommended per person), airfare, passport and/or individual visa fees, Israel ETA-IL fees, personal travel insurance, laundry, beverages and items not on the regular menu of the included meals, additional baggage in excess of airport allowance, optional sightseeing tours, and all expenses of a purely personal nature.
